

AN OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENT

Judy Attwater and her German Shepherd Dogs “Dusty” and “Emma” were recently presented with an Outstanding Achievement award by the NSW German Shepherd Dog League. Judy’s dog “Dusty” (Australian Champion Tristania Derniere-Nee CDX TDX AD JD HT ET “A””Z” BS Cl I), now 10 years old, is believed to be the only German Shepherd Dog in Australia with titles in every event a German Shepherd Dog is eligible to compete in. Not only is “Dusty” breed surveyed Class I (the highest grading given by the German Shepherd Dog Council), she is also an Australian Champion in the show ring. In performance events “Dusty” has titles in obedience, tracking, agility, jumping, herding and endurance.

“Dusty’s” daughter “Emma” (Australian Champion Tristania Emelyne TD AD PT ET “A””Z”) is also a show ring champion with performance titles in tracking, agility, herding and endurance (and expecting to add to these in the future!). “Emma” is believed to be the first German Shepherd Dog in NSW to earn a herding title.

The German Shepherd Dog League’s Outstanding Achievement award is a prestigious award which is given rarely – congratulations Judy, “Dusty” & “Emma”!
